REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Take time to recreate... Come in and register for summer fun activities at Salem's Recreation Department. Registrations for Salem residents begin Wednesday, May 19 from 9:00am to 6:00pm in the Town Hall's Knightly Meeting Room (lower level). You may register for programs after this date but please remember program space is limited and registrations are on a first come first serve basis. Provided space is available, program registrations will begin for non-residents on Wednesday, May 26 and will be assessed an additional \$10.00 non-resident registration fee. Any individual enrolling in our Recreation programs is required to pay the registration fee at the time of registration. The Town charges an additional \$25.00 fee for every check that is returned. Proof of residency is required at registration for the resident rate.

- ✓ No telephone or mail in registrations will be accepted.
- ✓ No refunds unless the Recreation Department cancels the program.
- ✓ The Recreation Department establishes a minimum and maximum number of registrants for each class. If the minimum size is not reached, the class will be canceled and the registration fee will be returned.
- ✓ Parents need to register their own children.

SKYHAWKS CAMPS

The Recreation Department with Skyhawks is offering safe, fun and skill-focused sport camps. The 4-day camps will be held at Morse field (adjacent to Soule School). Application forms are required and obtained at the Recreation Department when you register. *If there is an inclement weather day, the make-up day is Friday on the same week that camp is scheduled.*

TINY-HAWK: Camp is for children 3 to 4 years old (must be toilet trained). This camp introduces the essentials basketball and soccer. Through games and activities, campers explore balance, hand/eye coordination and skill development. Participants should bring appropriate clothing, water bottle, running shoes and sunscreen. Parents must stay on-site with their child.

SNAG GOLF: Camp is for children 5 to 8 years old. Skyhawks golf focuses on building the confidence of young athletes through proper technique and refining the essential skills of the game. Young athletes need proper focus on the fundamentals of form, swinging, putting and body positioning. Skyhawks has adopted the SNAG (Starting New At Golf) system to its curriculum and is designed for the entry-level player; it simplifies instruction for easy and effective transition onto the golf course. No need to bring your own clubs; all equipment is provided.

Participants should bring appropriate clothing, a snack, water bottle, running shoes, mouth-piece, protective gloves, helmet with full mask, lacrosse stick and sunscreen.
